


**At VantagePoint3,** we believe that pastors and church leaders have a responsibility for the formation and release of passion-filled disciples who will do their part in serving and leading wherever God plants them. 


# The Journey

is a six to eight month process that uniquely integrates leadership development, discipleship, and spiritual formation in a holistic, relationship-based style.

A facilitator-led discussion is the delivery method of *The Journey*. The role of the facilitator is not to be the “subject matter expert,” but to guide the group of eight to twelve people to a mutually beneficial destination. Each week’s material is much greater than you could discuss in a group, so you will prayerfully and skillfully decide how to set the stage, what to discuss and how to end your time together.



## Stage 1: Biblical Foundations:

invites us into an exploration and appreciation of Scripture’s transforming role for a lifetime of growth and service.

## Stage 2: Personal Foundations:

invites us to take inventory of our life story, recognizing God’s already present work along the way.

## Stage 3: Relational Foundations:

invites us to see the importance of relationships in our lives as a necessity in how we are formed into people of integrity, compassion and influence.

# A Way of Life

God is up to something good. Picking up where *The Journey* leaves off, **A Way of Life** encourages greater attention to and alignment with God's gracious way in your life, your community and the world. Three overarching themes structure the learning: friendship with God, community with others, and mission on the way.


At its core, the six to eight month process of **A Way of Life** invites you into a set of reflections, practices, and relationships that will help you explore and sustain a way of life faithful to God's good work.

Structured in identical fashion as *The Journey* with VantagePoint3 staff training your people at a central location, **A Way of Life** is a resource that will help you invest in the ongoing formation of your people, as well as continue to enhance the conversations of learning in your setting.




**Stage 1: Friendship with God:**

## Facilitator Training Retreats

As part of the investment into each facilitator, the VP3 team invites you to join a regional Facilitator Training Retreat. During this three-day event, facilitators are trained by a VP3 representative to become familiar with the content from **The Journey** or **A Way of Life**, consider how to implement these processes in their setting, and explore their own ongoing formation as a leader.

The impact of the Facilitator Training Retreat reaches beyond the three days together as facilitators come together via an online format throughout the duration of **The Journey** or **A Way of Life** processes. Three purposes for the ongoing facilitator learning include:

- To help facilitators continue to pay attention to their own formation.
- To return to various content sections and learning processes associated with **The Journey** or **A Way of Life** processes.
- To encourage facilitators to think about their context and next step learning for participants.

Facilitator Training Retreats are designed to help you learn how to invest in the deepening and empowering of your people, while at the same time helping you pay attention to your own growth toward Christ-likeness.

## Other VP3 Processes:

**The Equipping Experience:** *The Equipping Experience* is an eight-month experience intended for those who desire to learn and enhance the skills associated with the work of leadership. It will build on the participants' discoveries from **The Journey** or **A Way of Life** by continuing to ask questions of intimacy with God, identify as God's loved children, and our unique Kingdom responsibility.

**The Enriching Conversation:** *The Enriching Conversation* is a six to eight month small group process, which invites participants to explore how to invest in the growth and development of others in their local settings. *The Enriching Conversation* builds on the learning from **A Way of Life** or *The Equipping Experience*.
