Addressing Key Barriers



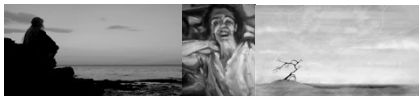
Busyness

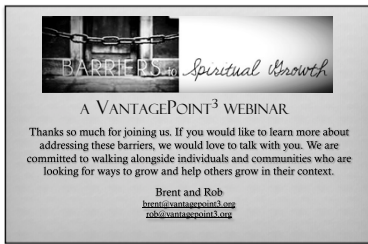
